## Save money on your **Medicare-covered insulin**

You'll pay no more than \$35 for a one-month supply of each covered insulin. The deductible doesn't apply.



# There are 2 ways that Medicare covers insulin:



## Part B (Medical Insurance) or Medicare Advantage (Part C)

Part B covers insulin if you use an insulin pump that's covered as durable medical equipment under Part B. Medicare Advantage Plans cover insulin.



## Drug coverage (Part D)

Part D covers insulin that's injectable, inhaled, or used with pumps that aren't covered as durable medical equipment under Part B.

Note: If your Part D plan covers your pump (like a disposable pump), it might cost more than \$35.
