



# Medicare

## Save money on your **Medicare-covered insulin**

You'll pay \$35 per month (or less)  
for each covered insulin drug, and  
no deductible for covered insulin.



# There are 2 ways that Medicare covers insulin:



## Part D (Drug coverage):

Insulin covered by your Medicare drug plan.

(Note: If your Part D plan covers disposable insulin patch pumps, the pump is considered an insulin supply, and might cost more than \$35.)



## Part B (Medical Insurance) or Part C (Medicare Advantage):

Insulin delivered through a pump that's covered under Medicare's durable medical equipment benefit.
