Medicare covers most vaccines for free!

Medicare Part D covers most vaccines at no cost to you. You'll pay no out-of-pocket costs for all adult vaccines recommended by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices ([CDC.gov/vaccines/hcp/acip-recs](https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/acip-recs)).



Here's what you need to know:



Your Medicare drug plan or health plan with drug coverage won't charge you a copayment or a deductible for vaccines that prevent shingles, whooping cough, tetanus, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), and more.



Stay up to date with vaccines to help protect yourself from disease and severe illness.



Talk with your doctor about which recommended vaccines are right for you.
