

## Medicare covers most vaccines for free!

Medicare Part D covers most vaccines at no cost to you. You'll pay no out-of-pockets costs for all adult vaccines recommended by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (CDC.gov/vaccines/hcp/acip-recs).



## Here's what you need to know:

- Your Medicare drug plan or health plan with drug coverage won't charge you a copayment or a deductible for vaccines that prevent shingles, whooping cough, tetanus, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), and more.
- Stay up to date with vaccines to help protect yourself from disease and severe illness.
- Talk with your doctor about which recommended vaccines are right for you.
